The Principalship continues to be a demanding position and often there are few colleagues available with whom to confer as you switch positions or begin the role for the first time. Principals have expressed an interest in the past of having a cohort group available to get helpful ideas, identify possible suggestions, share successes, and generally extend their learning as they try to apply their skills and knowledge to a new position.

Principals who are in their first, second or third years of the principalship may register for this series. During the six customized half-day meetings, there will be time set aside *at the beginning of the session* for the group to identify areas of concern for problem solving.

At the end of the first session, and at the end of each of the following sessions, participants will identify the areas of interest *for further learning* at the next session.

Presenter: Dr. Kenneth Chapman, Ed.D. is a consultant with Research for Better Teaching and has conducted extensive workshops as a trainer for the Massachusetts Elementary School Principals' Association and the National Association of Elementary School Principals in the areas of leadership, group process, and fiscal and organizational development. Dr. Chapman was a practicing school administrator in Massachusetts for over 20 years. He also currently serves as the lead facilitator for the MESPA Certification Program. He has been a full-time consultant with school districts across the state and nation for the last fourteen years.
