Is your computer making your life more difficult? Is it running slowly, giving you arcane error messages, or just refusing to work at all? Do you feel you need to be more in control of what is going on with your computer and some ideas about how to fix it? This one day class is designed for educators who need to gain a better understanding of how all their technology works: computer, printer, 'plug and play' devices, network, and internet. It will also help you to understand why sometimes these technologies don't work the way they should due to issues such as viruses, equipment failure, older technology meeting newer applications, missing or corrupted files, network and/or internet traffic, etc. This workshop will introduce you to some simple troubleshooting strategies that will help you get back up and running smoothly in no time. Bring a technology problem you have been having and we'll help you figure out how to fix it!

Presenters: Glenn Foley, is the Technology Engineer for the MESPA Education and Technology Center. Before coming to MESPA he worked for Digital Equipment Corporation for 21.5 years in various rolls ranging from Assembly Technician to Regional Support Engineering. He has also worked on Ethernet during the development stages with DEC, Intel, Xerox, and 3Comm. He began his work for MESPA in 1994 as a contractor for its network/computer support.

Robert Tucker, is an Education and Technology Specialist with the MESPA Education & Technology Center, Marlborough, Massachusetts. He serves as director of the Assistive Technology Project and also directs the Instructional Technology Master's/Certification program. His areas of expertise include professional development, technology planning, and assistive technologies and Universal Design for Learning. Mr. Tucker was an education specialist at the Center for Applied Special Technologies (CAST) of Peabody, Massachusetts. Prior to joining CAST, Mr. Tucker was with the Chapter 1 Computer Cooperative Center (C4), Maynard, Massachusetts for six years. A former elementary school teacher in Lexington, his degrees include a B.A. from the University of Massachusetts, and a M.Ed. from Harvard University Graduate School of Education.
