### **II - Physical Science: Balance and Motion at the Circus**

Everybody loves a circus! So what better theme to explore the concepts of forces, balance and motion? But not everything at the circus is moving the same way. Some things move from one place to another. Other things go around and around in a rotational motion. Still other things are stationary, stable for a time, balanced on a thin line between stop and go. These are some of the phenomena that students experience in this workshop. Teachers will also learn how to assess inquiry-based student work

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**Presenter: Mary Jo Diem** has assisted teachers, administrators, parents, and school board members, in the reforming of science and mathematics programs from kindergarten through high school, in both public and private schools. In the last twenty years, she has worked with over 4800 teachers in over 50 school districts.

Mary Jo's work centers on the development of guiding principals from the TIMS study [Third International Mathematics and Science Study] and through the application of "essentials of cognitive research." She is presently an adjunct instructor at Northeastern University in the School of Education.

Her goal is to assist educational professionals in realizing that recent scientific research calls for nothing less than a paradigm shift in the way we think about teaching and learning at all levels in this country.
