IV - Earth Science: Blowing in the Wind

What better way to demonstrate the power of inquiry than to explore something that is all around us-air! Teachers will investigate this very important mixture of gasses. They will explore the properties and behavior of air and how it can be used in everyday life. Air plays an essential role in flight as well, so teachers will utilize inquiry to design and construct various devices that float through air and experiment to find out ways to improve the overall performance of these devices.

Presenter: Mary Jo Diem has assisted teachers, administrators, parents, and school board members, in the reforming of science and mathematics programs from kindergarten through high school, in both public and private schools. In the last twenty years, she has worked with over 4800 teachers in over 50 school districts.

Mary Jo's work centers on the development of guiding principals from the TIMS study [Third International Mathematics and Science Study] and through the application of "essentials of cognitive research." She is presently an adjunct instructor at Northeastern University in the School of Education.

Her goal is to assist educational professionals in realizing that recent scientific research calls for nothing less than a paradigm shift in the way we think about teaching and learning at all levels in this country.
