This workshop will explore the critical elements of ethical leadership with an emphasis on

- Key concepts of ethical leadership
- Ethical virtues essential for school leadership
- Strategies to deal effectively with ethical dilemmas

Participants will have opportunities to reflect and assess their own ethical dispositions and use case studies to apply problem-solving skills to ethical dilemmas.

Ronald J. Areglado, Ed. D., is currently President of the Center for Ethical and Moral Leadership, a consulting firm that specializes in leadership development for both profit and non-profit organizations. Ron has an extensive and varied professional background. He has been a teacher, principal, superintendent and has worked with the Massachusetts State Department of Education and the National Association of Elementary School Principals where he was the Associate Executive Director of Programs. He is an author and the recipient of several state and national awards for outstanding educational leadership. As an adjunct professor in Massachusetts and Rhode Island, he teaches aspiring and practicing leaders about contemporary leadership and organizational behavior issues. Ron is a passionate advocate for education and believes our profession is a “sacred” calling. In his years of service, he has worked with literally hundreds of principals across the nation. He is convinced that principals must be inspirational and moral leaders who, as beacons of hope, brighten the pathway for our nation’s students and teachers.
