Google Docs allows users to create documents, spreadsheets, presentations, and forms that are stored online and accessible from any computer. Students will learn to create a wiki using Google Sites to create interactive classrooms sites and collaborative project-based lessons for students. Ample online resources will be provided. Three graduate credits optionally will be available from Fitchburg State College.
